HG Learning Conversation, Subject Interviews and Course Selection

Dear Parents/Caregivers,

This **Wednesday 22nd August**, you have the opportunity to participate in a discussion with your child and their Home Group Teacher in regards to their learning and progress this year. There is also an opportunity to make appointments with current subject teachers to discuss current progress in semester 2 courses.

Just to reiterate:

Appointments are to be made with **current teachers** to discuss learning for **this semester**.

Once you have attended your Home Group and any other subject appointments, it is essential to complete Course Selection for 2019 with a member of our leadership team. You do not require an appointment for Course Selection, instead a member of our staff will direct you to the most appropriate leader to complete the process.

As part of course selection for 2019, Year 9 students have been provided with a draft Year 10 Course Selection Card to complete prior to Course Selection Day on **Wednesday 22nd August, 2018**. This **must be brought with them** to Learning Conversations, to enable successful Course Selection.

If you are unable to attend, it is essential that your child bring a completed signed Course Card and provide it to their Home Group Teacher. If there are any concerns, a member of staff will contact you.

It is extremely important for students to explore the options for Year 10 in the Year 8-10 Course Handbook, which can be accessed online via our school website.

Learning Conversations and **Course Selection** will be held in the **Learning Hub, beginning at 1:00pm** and concluding at **8:00pm**. This is a school closure day.







The process for making your online appointment is as follows.

1. Go to <https://www.schoolinterviews.com.au/code>
2. Enter the code **xpx7h** and click “GO”

3. 
 - Enter your email
 - Full name
 - Select how many students (if there are siblings) to make appointments
 - Enter student(s) name(s)
 - Click “GO”

4. 
 - Select the relevant teachers and subjects
 - Click “Go”

5. 
 - Select your appointment time and click “GO”

6. Print or keep a record of your booking.
An email notification will be sent and you can reschedule your booking at any time, by logging back into School Interviews or via the link in the confirmation email.

If you do NOT have access to the internet to make your booking, your child can do so at school or you can phone the school on 8329 7287 to make an appointment time.
