

## Learning Conversations & Course Selection

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Dear Parents/Carers & Families,

On Wednesday 18 August, 1pm - 8pm, we will be holding Learning Conversations and Course Selection for Year 7 - 11 students. Current Year 12 students will also participate in Learning Conversations, with the option of accessing support in completing their SATAC applications.

Unless we are advised otherwise by SA Health, Learning Conversation and Course Selection will be a face-to-face event, and we will be implementing COVID-safe practices. Learning Conversations and Course Selection for students in Middle School Home Groups (current Year 7-9s) will be based in the Learning Hub. Learning Conversations and Course Selection for students in Senior School Home Groups (current Year 10-12s) will be based in the STEM Building. In the event of any restrictions or changes, you will be notified by email and via the school's social media platforms.

This is an important opportunity to discuss your young person's learning and achievement with their teachers and select their courses for 2022. There is clear research showing the link between positive parent and school relationships, and the achievement of students. Your collaboration with teachers to support your young person's success and make informed decisions regarding their courses is extremely important.





### The process for making your online appointment is as follows

1. Go to <https://www.schoolinterviews.com.au/>
2. Enter the code **4snea** and click 'GO'

Select how many students (if there are siblings) to make appointments

Click 'Go'

Appointments are to be made with current subject teachers & homegroup teacher  
Select the relevant teachers and subjects  
Click 'Go'

Select your appointment time(s) and click 'Go'

6. Print or keep a record of your booking.  
An email notification will be sent and you can reschedule your booking at any time, by logging back into School Interviews or via the link in the confirmation email.
