Key information regarding the end of the year

Final classes, Farewell Assembly and Celebration Breakfast

- Formal Year 12 classes will finish on Thursday 21 October (Week 2, Term 4). Year 12 students are expected to attend and participate in all lessons up to and including this date.
- A farewell assembly for the Year 12 students will take place on Thursday 21 October (Week 2, Term 4). This is a special whole-school gathering during which we will celebrate the Class of 2021. Please note, students must be in **full school uniform** to participate in the assembly, and will be required to wear masks.
- A celebration breakfast for all Year 12 students will be held on Friday 22 October (Week 2, Term 4), from 8:00-10:00am. Year 12 Students will be dismissed following the breakfast and will be required to leave the school grounds.

End of year Examinations

- All students who have an end of year examination must attend the Structured Examination Revision Week at Wirreanda Secondary School (Week 3, Term 4). Students have received revision schedules from their subject teachers.
- The Year 12 examination period begins on Monday 1 November and concludes on Friday 12 November. Please refer to the timetable on the following page for the dates and times of specific exams.
- Any questions about Year 12 examinations should be directed to Mr Brad Stubing.

All exams will be held in Upstairs B Block unless otherwise stated. Students must arrive in **the Atrium** at least 15 minutes prior to the exam and check in with the supervising teacher. Please note, students must attend their exams **in full school uniform** and bring their **registration slips** (which will be provided closer to exams) with them.

Return of school materials

Students need to return any textbooks, laptops, graphics calculators and Sports Uniforms to the Bookroom in the Learning Hub following the completion of their final classes or examinations, and no later than **Thursday 11 November**. Any outstanding invoices must also be paid by this date, after which students will be asked to complete their School Leaver Form.

Graduation Ceremony

The Graduation Ceremony will be held on Monday 15 November at 6.30pm in the new Wirreanda Secondary School Theatre. The ceremony will be the first event for students and families to be held in the new theatre, a key aspect of the recent building works, and is one that we look forward to celebrating with our Wirreanda Secondary School community. Students will receive two guest tickets at no cost. Requests for additional guest tickets will be considered subject to covid-density requirements and equity in distribution. Students receiving a Year 12 Certificate must have successfully completed 200 credits and met the SACE pattern. Greater detail regarding collecting tickets will be posted on our Social Media over the next few weeks Term 4.
